Classes after May 17th (Notice)

In response to its own state of emergency issued by Fukui prefecture on April 22nd, the University of Fukui has issued its own special alert and offered all classes online (on-demand and real time) from the Monday of April 26th to the Sunday of May 16th. Since some infection cases of both faculty & staff members and students have been confirmed during this period, and the infection situation is still expanding in Fukui and neighboring prefectures, we have decided to extend the period of our own special alert to May 31st (Mon.). As a result, we would like to inform you that all classes will continue to be offered online until the Monday of May 31st. Some schools may conduct face-to-face classes for activities such as experiments, practical training, or PBL with sufficient consideration given to infection prevention. For details of class offerings, please make sure to check the website of each school or graduate school and the student portal.

We ask you to refrain from coming on campus unless absolutely necessary during this period of distance learning and observe our own special alert.
