Language Requirements	Undergraduate students are required to submit either a Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) test score as part of your application to the University of Findlay. Your score will determine if you “test out” of Intensive English Language Program (IELP) and can be directly admitted into your undergraduate or graduate program.

Students may not add a course or change sections after the sixth-class day of the semester without also receiving written permission from the instructor.</p>
